## HOW TO CLEAN REUSABLE BAGS

Wash by hand using warm soapy water. For machine wash, use the gentlest cycle to prevent damage. Allow them to air dry.

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

Millions of tons of plastics are produced every year. Bisphenol A (BPA), an endocrine disruptor which is used in the production of plastics, is currently one of the highest volume of chemicals produced annually. BPA concentrations found in human body generates negative effect by creating changes in prostate, breast, mammary glands, testes, brain structure and more. This in turn, could lead to several health concerns. As consumers, we have to be mindful of our health by minimizing plastic consumption in order to cut down its negative effects.



## **TIPS IN CUTTING DOWN THE USE OF PLASTIC**

- Say no to plastic and use glass bottles instead
- Avoid using plastic utensils, plastic dishes, and plastic bottles. Try other alternatives like glass or stainless steel
- When using plastic, choose the ones made from polyethylene and polypropylene
- Opt for Silicone instead of latex too.
- Say no to plastic packaging. This is one of the reasons why there's unregulated plastic consumption in our society
- Choose reusable materials rather than disposable ones.
- Use glass containers or reusable fabric bags instead of using plastics in storing your food. This way, you can avoid the risk of chemicals leaching into your food.

## BONUS TIPS FOR SIMPLE HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS

### Window Cleaner

Mix 1 tablespoon of cornstarch with 1 quart warm water

### Floor Cleaner

Mix 1 cup vinegar with 2 gallons water

### General Cleaner

Mix 4 tablespoons of baking soda in 1 quart warm water, or use plain baking soda with wet sponge.

### Eyeglass Cleaner

Mix 8 ounces of ammonia with 32 ounces of rubbing alcohol

### Daily Shower Cleaner

1 cup vinegar, ½ teaspoon liquid dishwashing soap, and 1.4 cup dishwashing rinse agent

### Toilet Bowl Cleaner

Drop denture cleaning tablet into bowl and let sit

### Dusting

Reuse dryer sheets for dusting instead of the new Pledge or Swiffer cloths.

### Aluminum Cleaner

Mix 2 tablespoons cream of tartar with 1 quart hot water.


### Tub and Tile Cleaner

Mix ¼ cup baking soda with ½ cup white vinegar.

### Drain Cleaner

Add ½ cup of baking soda, then pour 1 cup of vinegar down drain. Let it sit for 20 minutes then flush with water.

Try these easy and simple cleaning tips. They are made with products that are convenient and safe for use. They worked well for me and they should work well for you too!
